At **Griffin Primary** we believe PE & Sport plays an important role in making our vision statement a reality for every pupil, with the potential to change young people's lives for the better.

Sport Premium Grant

Funding for schools will be calculated by the number of primary aged pupils (between the ages of 5 and 11). Schools with 17 or more eligible pupils will receive a lump sum of £16,000 plus an additional payment of £10 per pupil.

What does the Sport Premium mean for our School?

At Griffin Primary we have split up the funding by the three key areas for consideration; Physical Education, Healthy Active Lifestyles and Competitive Sport. We have decided to spend the Sport Premium Grant on the following:
