vidual and group photos of all of our pupils. Please can you ensure that your child is sent to school in appropriate uniform on Monday, so that they are ready for the photographers.

If your child has any siblings under the age of 3, and you have returned a slip to school for sibling photographs, you will receive a call from us to arrange a time

to come in next Tuesday. If you have more than one child in school, they will have sibling photos taken on Monday, with no need for you to come in the following day.

Attendance

As you can see, the attendance this week is incredibly low. The national requirement for attendance in school, is 96%. Children who are not brought into school regularly and on time, will risk being reported to the Local Authority for further action.

We will also be sending letters out to those children who have poor attendance. If your child's attendance is 98% or below, you may receive a letter so that you can act now to avoid it falling any further. Of course, we understand absence is sometimes unavoidable due to family or medical circumstances. However, it is important that we work together with parents to make sure that we are doing everything possible to support and encourage improved attendance.
