Important Reminders

Attendance and Punctuality

Classroom doors close promptly at **8.55am**, and a large number of students are arriving late every day. These children are being closely monitored and are receiving late marks. This can seriously impact on their overall attendance. Please ensure your child arrives at school on time every day.

Collecting Children On Time
