





This week in English we will be...



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
Lesson 1

If you're in Reception then have a go at using your phonics to write some of the words yourself.




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Lesson 2

Send us photos of your items on tapestry



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

Instructions:


Can you make your favourite sandwich with the help of an adult?

Talk to that adult about what you need to do and in what order.


Reception challenge: can you use your phonics to write your instructions down

Maths




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Lesson 1



Shape hunt:

Can you find anything square?








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Lesson 1

Find something that is bumpy


Find something that is metal
