

Use your objects to create a short story.








Eye Spy-

Challenge-

Try hunting with your eyes closed!





My History-

Ask your adult if you can look at some old photos and talk about them. You might learn about a special family event or some achievements you have done growing up.

<u>Reception-</u> You could write a sentence about a photo using your phonics knowledge.
