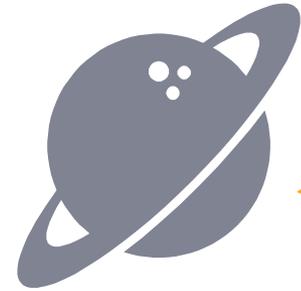



Inside the box


Under the box

Go around your house or garden and find 3 things. Can you put them in order of longest to shortest?


Reception-

Friday 8th May is VE Day





Look carefully at the Union Jack flag.

Challenge-What shape can you make if you put 2 triangles together?








Continuous provision
