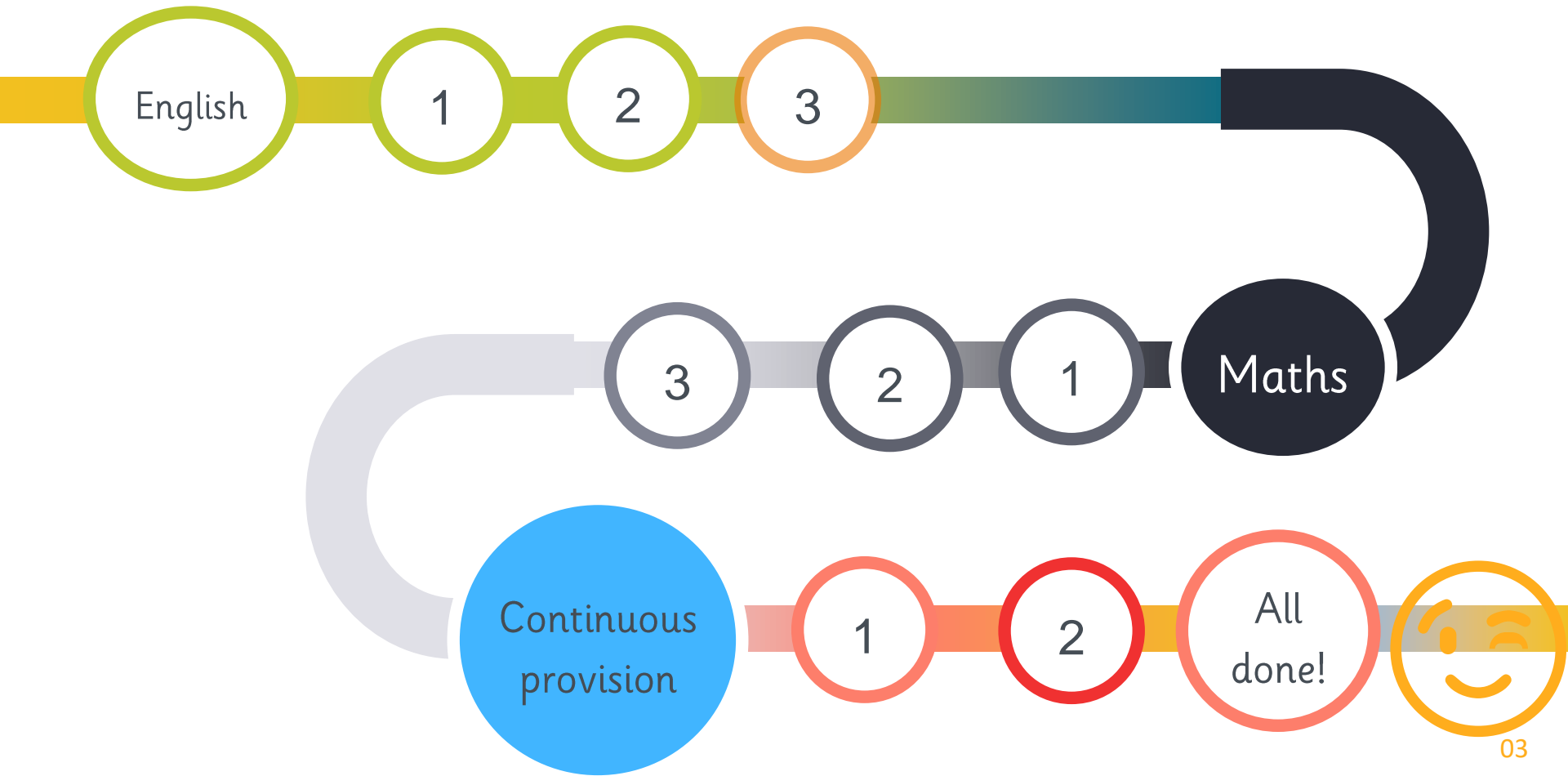

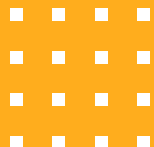

## Estimation jars (2)

Using the same jars or boxes as lesson 1, fill them half full. Can you estimate and check by counting how many there are when it is half full.

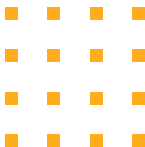
Reception Can you create some 2 digit numbers?

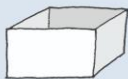
# Make a simple hedgehog house

## You will need:

- Medium-sized plastic storage box



- Stanley knife



- Leaf litter



- Dry grass or straw



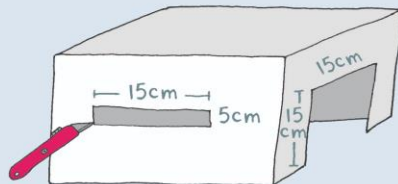
- Carrier bag



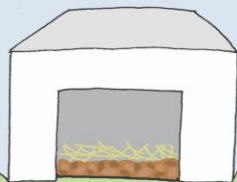
- Twigs and dry leaves



- 1 Cut two side air vents and an entrance into the plastic box.



- 2 Put some leaf litter inside the box, with clean, dry grass or straw on top.



- 3 Tuck the box near a hedge (with the entrance facing south if possible).

- 4 Put an opened-up carrier bag over the top of the box, then cover with twigs, dry grass and leaves.

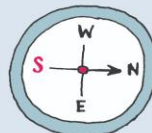
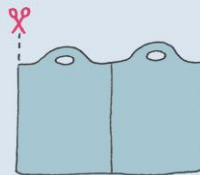
