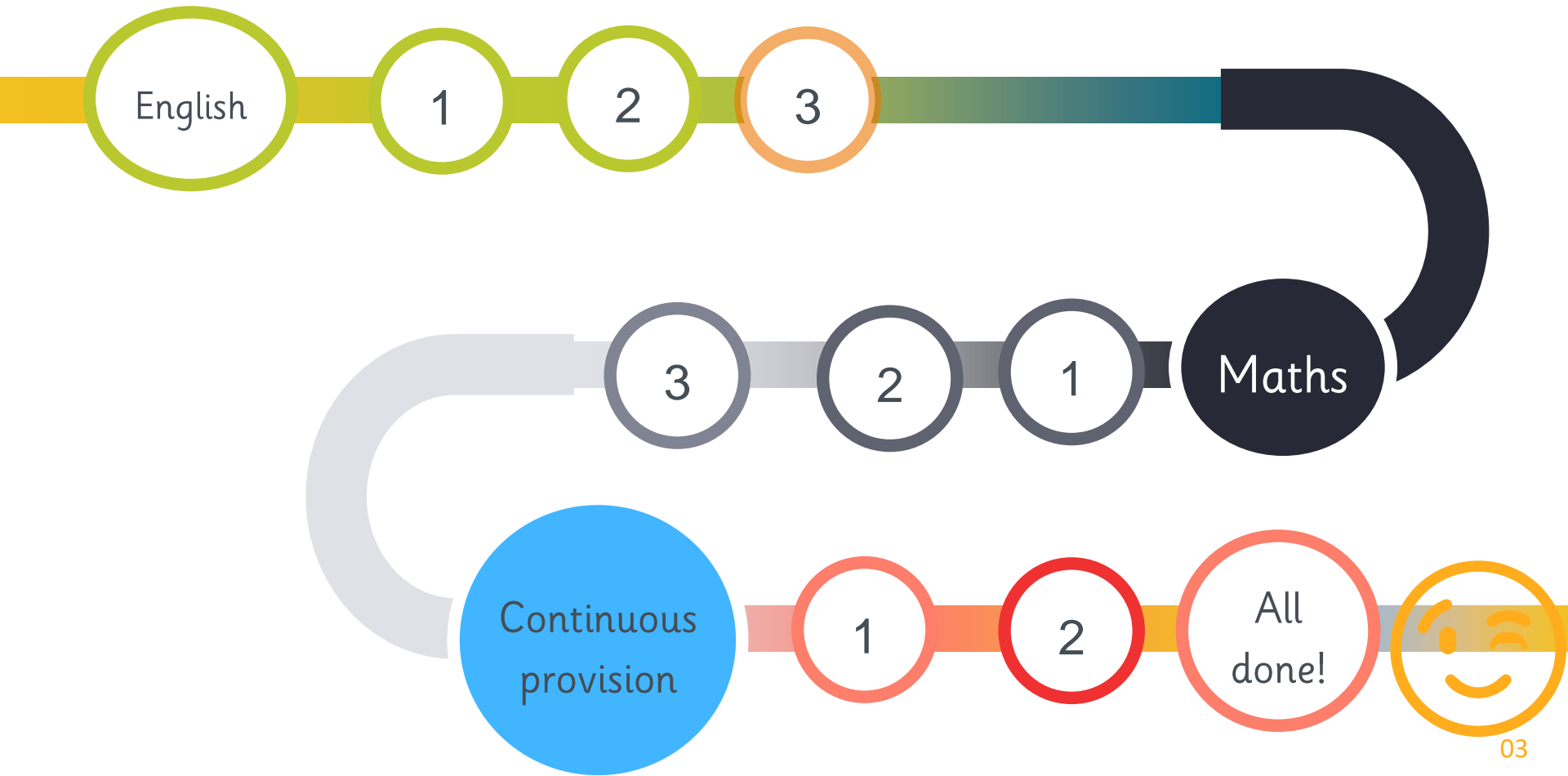

English

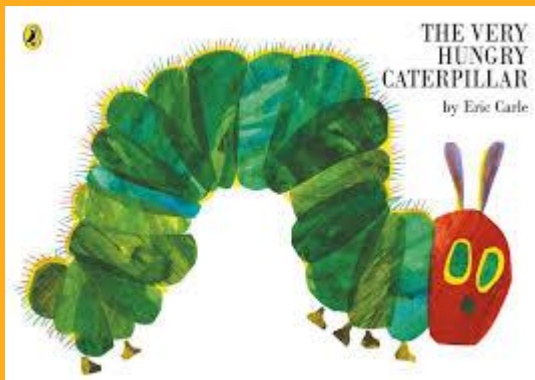

Lesson 2

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Hopscotch

Using chalks on the floor or on a large roll of paper draw a hopscotch and play the game using a stone or pebble to place on the numbers and practise your hopping and jumping.



Reception: Can you name one more or one less than some numbers?



Lesson 3

Obstacle course



Inside or outside your house use objects to create your own obstacle course. Practise going in between, over, under etc.

Reception Can you give people instructions to complete your obstacle course.
