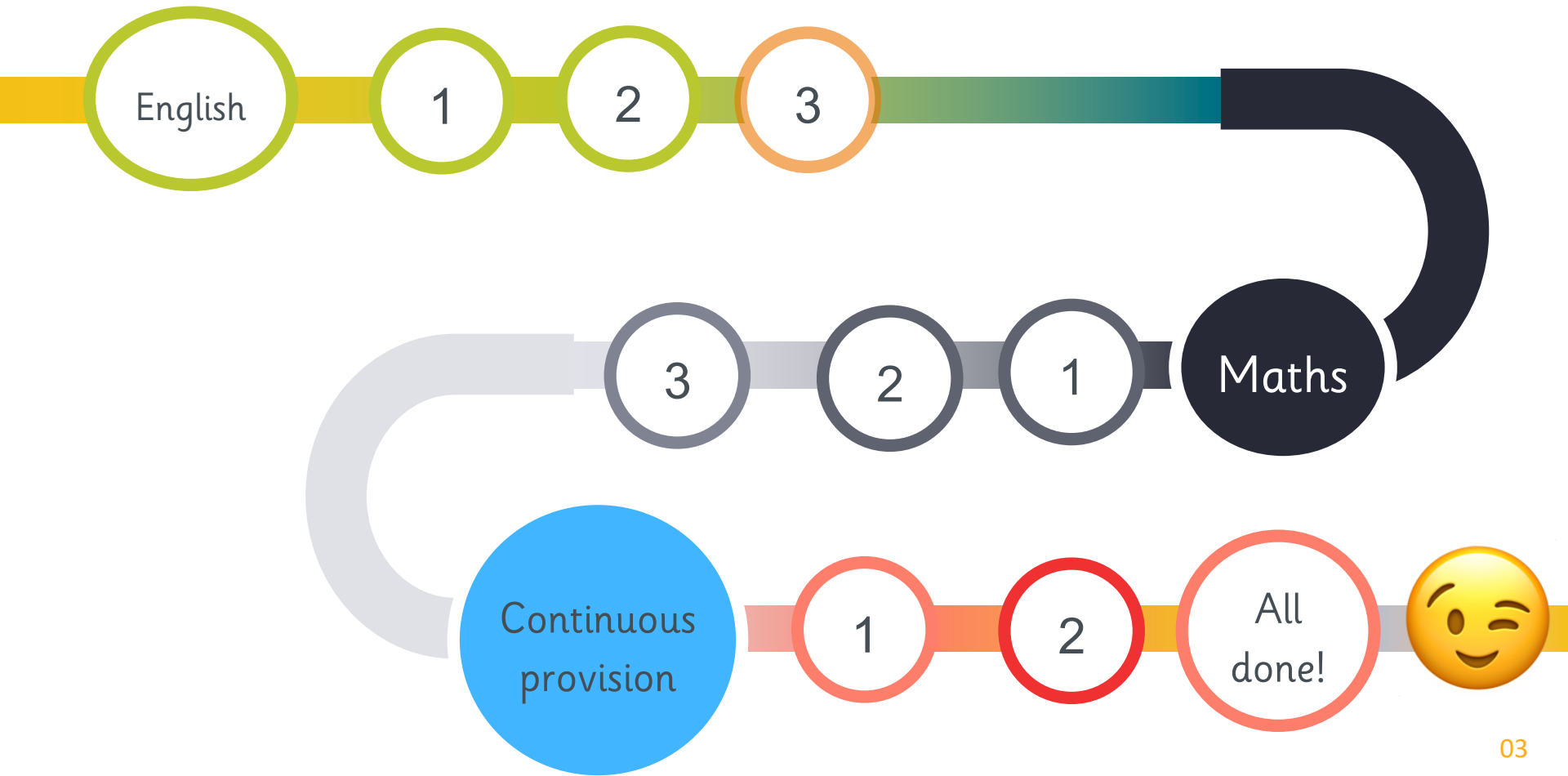

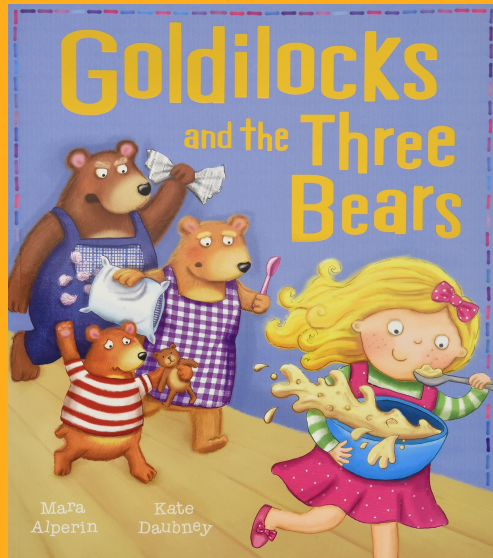

Clap, clap, clap.



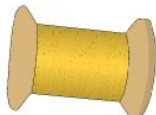
Wind it back again,

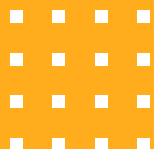
Sorting colours
