We will be looking at the festivals/ celebrations of Diwali and Bonfire night. We will look at how colour is used in different celebrations and how people with different beliefs celebrate.

We have read the story of Rama and Sita and so you might want to ask your child questions about the story e.g- what happened, their favourite part, were all of the characters good?

In maths we have looked, in detail, at number 1-5. We have learnt to add actions to numbers, how to write them, greater and fewer amounts and the different shapes linked with the numbers.
