Accessing Remote Learning **A Parent's Guide**

At Griffin, we have chosen to use Microsoft Teams as part of our remote learning offer to children. This is an online platform that can be accessed from home, or anywhere with an internet connection.

Teams has been selected because:

- It is a straightforward system to use
- It can be accessed on computers, tablets and mobile phones
- **Protecting your child's data is Microsoft's top priority.**

In this booklet, you will find a brief introduction to Teams, including what it will look like once you have logged in on a computer, and on a mobile phone/tablet.

Further details about specific lessons and tasks will be sent to children/parents, using the Microsoft Office.com email function. This uses Outlook online, and although you can download an app for Outlook/emails as well, you do not need to do this to access messages from your child's teachers.

Your children's learning can happen anywhere with Microsoft 365 online. Get to know our tools made to support learners of all ages and abilities, and see how your child's core subjects and class discussions can happen with support from Microsoft Education.


Accessing Microsoft 365

Your Microsoft 365 Education login is free, and children can log into their school accounts at [Office.com](https://www.office.com), where they'll have access to Microsoft Teams. From this home base, children can open Office apps in their web browser.

How will my child communicate with their teacher and class?

Using Teams!

Teams is an online classroom hub, where your student can chat with their whole class, in groups with other students, and also one-to-one with their teachers.




How do I access work from my child's class?

Click on your class icon and this will take you directly to your classroom hub. Access the work that has been set by the class teacher, by clicking on "files" on the top menu bar. This will redirect you to the list of work files which need completing.

What if I need extra support?

Select "New Conversation" in Teams, to have a one-to-one discussion with your teacher. You can also contact your teacher with any other questions this way as well.

If you don't have access to a computer/laptop, you can also download "Microsoft Teams" in the app store (on iPhones, android phones and tablets).


