## **Words of the fortnight to investigate**

Frozen icicle frost melt

Talk about what these words mean. Can your child use these words correctly in a sentence? Help them by modelling a sentence for them.

## **Phonics game to play**

Can you play the reading game? Ask an adult to read the words to you and then throw the dice and practice reading and writing the phase 2 tricky words!
