- Enjoying reading, discussing, and answering questions about Katie in London – James Mayhew.

Together we will master...writing:

- Write a narrative based on Katie in London – James Mayhew.
- Explore and write non-chronological reports.

Together we will master...maths:

- Numbers to 40.
- Addition and subtraction word problems
- Multiplication

Together we will master...science:

- Identify our senses and know which body parts they are linked to.
- Use our senses to explore.
- Continue recognising features of the seasons – winter.

Together we will master...PE

- Work on our team building skills.
- Complete orienteering courses around the school.
- Use a map to find hidden clues.

Together we will master...geography:

- Know about Hull and its landmarks.
- Identify physical features of England and Wales.
- Learn about London and its landmarks.

**Year One  
Term - Spring 1**

Together we will master...PSHE:

- Explore how to keep ourselves healthy, including what is not healthy.
- Learn about germs.
- Explore how to keep ourselves safe around the home and school.
- Understand how medicines can help us and how to be safe with them.
- How to cross the road safely.

**What can you do to support your child?**

Practise number recognition, number and letter formation/ weekly spellings including the phonic sounds and tricky words.

Read with your child daily.

Ask children questions about the book they have been reading.

Encourage the use of Big Club and Purple Mash.

Together we will master...Computing

- Logging into computers and online learning resources safely.
- How to keep ourselves safe when using the internet.

Together we will master...DT:

- Evaluate existing products.
- Learn where food comes from.
- Design and make a sandwich.
- Evaluate our own product and improve it.

Together we will master...RE:

- Explore who is special to us.
- Think about how we would welcome special people.
- Learn about the Easter story.

Together we will master...music:

- Listen to, appraise, and improvise music based on Latin music.

## Year One Routines:

- **Spellings** – these will be given out every Monday and the children will be tested on Friday of the same week.
- **Home reading** – reading will continue on bug club and children have a log in for this. Those children in school will read to an adult in school but will not be bringing a reading book home at the moment. 1:1 reading will continue on Teams for pupils working from home.
- **Purple Mash** – children all have a personal log in which allows them to access a range of learning activities at home.
- **Water bottles** – please ensure your child has a **clear water bottle, containing only water** in school every day. This must be taken home every evening to be washed and re-filled.
- **PE** - Our day for PE is Thursday. Children need to come to school in their full PE kit including trainers, warm jogging bottoms and a warm top. PE will take place outside. Long hair must be tied back, and jewellery removed.
- **Remote Learning** – We will be teaching live lessons at these times:
  - 9:15am – Phonics
  - 10:15am – English (Writing)
  - 11:10am – Maths
  - 12:45pm – Wellbeing activities
  - 1:15pm – Guiding Reading
