Together we will master...reading:

We are reading the story 'Meerkat mail.
 The children will be answering questions, including inference questions based on what they have read and sequencing the story.

Together we will master...writing:

- We will be exploring narrative writing through letters and creating their own non-chronological report about health.
- We will also be learning how to use expanded noun phrases, subordinate clauses and apostrophes.

<u>Together we will master...maths:</u>

- We will be learning how to count, add and subtract money using both pounds and pence.
- We will also be learning about 2D shapes including the names and reflections.

Together we will master...science:

- We will identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited.
- We will describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants.

Together we will master....geography

- We will be discovering hot and cold places including where they are in the world and the features of these places.
- We will also use map skills and directions to plan a route.
