 We will be reading and answering comprehension questions based on the books 'Hurricane' by David Wiesner and 'The Mousehole Cat' by Anotona Barber.

<u>Together we will master...writing:</u>

 We will be writing; non-chronological reports, linked to our science topic 'Plants', action stories linked to our geography topic 'Weather and Climate' and poems linked to 'Slowly' by James Reeves.

<u>Together we will master...maths:</u>

 We will be exploring units of measure focusing on length, mass, and volume.

Together we will master...science:

 We will be learning about plants. We will explore the parts of plants and their functions, as well as investigating what plants need to grow, how water is transported in plants and the importance of pollination and seed dispersal.
