- **Home reading** every child will have a school reading book, in a Griffin book bag which must returned to school every Friday, a new book will be sent home on Mondays only. We expect children to read at home daily. Please ensure reading records are dated and signed by an adult. We will be keeping a log of how many times children have read.
- Bug Club (Active Learn) Pupils all have a personal log in which allows them to access a range of reading books at home.
- Purple Mash Children all have a personal log in which allows them to access a range of learning activities at home.
- Times Table Rock Stars Children have their own log in for this APP allowing them to practise their tables at home.
- Water bottles Please ensure your child has a clear water bottle, containing only water in school every day. This must be taken home every evening to be washed and re-filled.
- **PE** is on a Friday. PE kit will be provided by school. Please ensure children have suitable footwear. Long hair must be tied back, and jewellery removed. If wearing tights, pupils will need a pair of socks.
- End of the day routine children will be lined up in their zone, at the end of the day.
