Maths

Understanding position through words e.g. The bag is **under** the table (without pointing).

Use one of your child's toys, such as a teddy. Move the teddy around the room.



Encourage use of positional language such as under, on top of, next to, behind, in front of

Ask "Where is teddy?" "Where is teddy now?"

Words to investigate

under

behind

next to

Talk about what these words mean. Model how to say each word and ask your child to copy. Challenge: Like the maths game, but this time can your child *show* what these words mean? E.g., go **under** the dining table, stand **behind** the chair, sit **next to** your teddy etc.

Phonics game

Voice sounds: Play an animal-themed guessing game. Make some sound effects for different animal noises and ask your child to guess what animal sound you were making. You could 'miaow' like a cat, 'woof' like a dog or 'hiss' like a snake. Take it in turns. What other animal sounds could you make?
