Nursery rhyme

Maths

Practise counting from one to five. Use objects in your home or garden to practise counting accurately. Encourage your child to move the object as they count. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5! You could try counting sweets, fruit, lego bricks, socks... anything!

Can your child show the correct number of fingers when asked?



Words to investigate

chilly

icy

winter

Talk about what these words mean. Model how to say each word and ask your child to copy.
Challenge: model clapping the number of syllables in each word and ask your child to copy e.g. i-cy

Phonics game

Make a musical instrument: Use recyclable items such as empty water bottles, cereal boxes or jars along with beads or dried foods such as pasta or lentils to create your very own musical instrument! Experiment by making loud and quiet sounds. We would love to see and hear your creations on Tapestry!
