Maths

Look around your home for patterns. Discuss and describe the patterns you find with your child – these could be: spots on an item of clothing, different coloured stripes on an ironing board cover or flowers on wallpaper.



Words to investigate

pointy

spotty

stripy

Talk about what these words mean. Model how to say each word and ask your child to copy.

Challenge: Ask your child to find something that is 'pointy', 'spotty' or 'stripy' either in your home or when you are out and about.

Phonics game

I spy: Play 'I spy' using sounds from around your home. E.g. take your child/ren into different rooms in the house and say 'I spy with my little eye something that makes the sound...' then rustle a bag of crisps, boil the kettle or run the tap. Take it in turns. What other sounds around the home could you spy?
