Words to investigate

Talk about what these words mean. Model how to say each word and ask your child to copy.

Challenge: Which animals do you know that have a tail? Horns? Fur?

Phonics game

Initial Sounds: Find objects around your home beginning with the same letter sound for example 'sssssss' for sock, sandwich, sausages, sofa etc.
