Talk about what these words mean. Can your child use these words correctly in a sentence? Help them by modelling a sentence for them.

Phonics game to play

Syllable game- Go on a hunt around the house or use the people you live with to clap out how many syllables they have. E.g Laptop- lap-top, 2 claps. Can you find an object or person with more than 4 syllables?
