

Together we will master...reading:

- Understand the features and purpose of specific paragraphs in non-fiction texts.
- To read the book Charlotte's Web by E.B.White.
- To make predictions based on theme and genre.
- To answer retrieval questions.
- Identify structural features looking at theme, moral and action.

Together we will master...writing:

- To write an information text linked to science (habitats)
- Use subordinate clauses, introductory paragraphs and prepositions.
- Write an additional chapter for Charlotte's Web.
- Write a persuasive text linked to Geography – encouraging more houses to be built in Hull.

Together we will master...maths:

- Understanding position and movement.
- Learning roman numerals.
- Revisiting number skills.

Together we will master...science:

- Grouping and classifying different plants and animals.
- Using classification keys.
- Classifying animals into vertebrate and invertebrate groups.
- Understanding both positive and negative impacts humans can have on the environment.

Together we will master...MFL:

- Understand the vocabulary from the story Goldilocks
- Be able to write my own goldilocks story in Spanish.

Together we will master...Geography

- Identify Hull and known places on a map
- Identifying land use of Roger Millward way
- Creating graphs based on data collected from Questionnaires
- Creating maps based on data and land uses.

Together we will master...PSHE:

- Understand how our body changes as we hit puberty
- Understand how we are born and why we show characteristics of our parents.
- Understand how a girl's body changes to carry a baby during pregnancy.
- Knowing that the changes happening are not in our control and how to deal with them.

What can you do to support your child?

Practice times tables/weekly spellings
Read with your child at least three times a week
Ask children questions about the book they have been reading on Bug Club
Encourage usage of Times Table Rockstars, Bug Club, Reading Plus and Purple Mash

- Thinking critically about art work.
- Exploring watercolours and creating shades.
- How to trace over simple objects
- Create our own 'in the style of' art work based on James Neal.

Together we will master...computing

- Understand how to code.
- Understand how to make programmes

Together we will master...PE:

- Learn how to play tennis with relevant stroke techniques.

Together we will master...music:

- Performing songs (with the music service)

Together we will master...RE:

- Explore how Christians pray and worship
- Understand how important the church is to Christians

Year 4 routines:

- **Spellings** – these will be given out every Monday and the children will be tested on Monday of the following week.
- **Home reading** – Children need to ensure their book bags are brought in on a Friday to be quarantined over the weekend.
- **Purple Mash** – Children all have a personal log in which allows them to access a range of learning activities at home.
- **Times Table Rockstars** - Children have their own log in for this APP allowing them to practise their tables at home.
- **Water bottles** – Please ensure your child has a **clear water bottle, containing only water** in school every day. This must be taken home every evening to be washed and re-filled.
- **PE** - Our day for PE is Friday (4DG) and Thursday (4TW). Children need to come to school in their full PE kit including trainers, warm jogging bottoms and a warm top. PE will take place outside. Long hair must be tied back, and jewellery removed.
