 We will be reading Time Hunters: Stone Age Rampage!

Together we will master...Writing:

 We will be writing a quest story linked to our history topic, an information text linked to our class read, a setting and character description based around our class read and a non-chronological report about plants!

<u>Together we will master...Maths:</u>

- We will be developing our multiplication and division skills.
- We will also be learning about length, mass and volume!

Together we will master...Science:

- We will learn about how light and shadows are formed.
- We will learn about how to protect our eyes.
- We will investigate the effect of transparent and translucent materials on shadows.

Together we will master...MFL:

- We will learn the names of ten fruits in Spanish.
- We will learn how to express an opinion about fruit in Spanish.
