We will be reading 'Flotsam' by David Wiesner during the first week back!

After that, we will be reading 'The Last Try' by Tom Palmer linking with our History focus!

Year 3 routines:

- Spellings these will be given out every Monday and the children will be tested on Monday of the following week.
