# Together we will master...

## English

*Pupils will be writing a story using Sierra Leone as a setting. We will use Lila and the Secret of Rain as a stimulus.*

*We will use our knowledge of Sierra Leone to write an information text.*

*We will write letters to our new teachers.*

## Maths

*In maths we are continuing to explore time and telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes.*

*We are also completing our Maths No Problem Assessments*

*We will be exploring the volume of different containers and exploring how much water they hold.*

## Science

*We will be learning about living things and their habitats.*

*We identify habitats as a home and give examples of animals and plants habitats.*

## Geography

*We will be learning about Sierra Leone and how the city of Freetown compares to Hull. We will look at the physical and human features of Freetown and Hull.*
