We have recently updated our

policy regarding the delivery and collection of pupils from school.

This policy is attached to the Parentmail with this newsletter.

In particular, please be aware that any pupils 5 or under must be collected by an adult and for this purpose an adult is defined as someone over the age of 16.

For pupils in Year 1, 2, 3 and 4 our preference is that pupils are collected by an adult (over 16), however on occasions we understand that this may not be possible. On these occasions the person collecting must be over 13, and a parent must have informed the school office who they are authorising to collect on their behalf.
