Research shows how many words children will hear if they are read to, by the time they are 5 years old.

If your child is never read to, 4,662 words.

If your child is read to 1-2 times per week 63,570 words.

If your child is read to 3-5 time per week 169,520 words.

If your child is read to daily 296,660 words.

If your child is read 5 books a day 1,483,399 words.
