#### Messages

Year 1 routines:

Children will continue to bring a book home every Monday to read with you at home. Their bookbag needs to be back in school on the Friday with new books sent home on a Monday. Pupils will also bring home a library book each Monday to read for pleasure.

- Weekly phonic blending sheets will be sent home to practise the sounds/words that have been taught the previous week. Pupils will also bring home a list of Tricky Words to be learned over the half term.
- Weekly Maths or Grammar homework will be sent home on a Monday and needs to be returned on a Friday.
- Weekly spellings will be sent home on a Monday, these need to be practised at home as they will be tested in school on the following Monday.
- Numbots Children all have a personal log in which allows them to access a range of learning activities at home.

• Water bottles - Please ensure your child has a water bottle, containing water, diluted juice or flavoured water in school every day. This must be taken home every evening to be washed and re-filled.

• PE - Children need to come to school in their full PE kit including trainers, jogging bottoms and a plain black, blue, grey or white top. PE will take place outdoors wherever possible. Long hair must be tied back, and jewellery removed.

• PE will ke lace on a Monday for ICS and a Friday for IKR.
