Literacy- Our text this half term will be 'The Treasure of Pirate Frank'. We will learn to signify this story and will begin to change parts to make the story our own. We will also do lots of exciting pirate writing!

Maths- We will be looking looking at numbers within 10 and counting beyond 20. We will explore what is meant by odd and even as well as looking at doubling amounts.

Expressive Arts- Through our class text, we will explore building pirate themed objects using 'junk materials' with the help of ScrapStore. We will learn and perform sea shanties and listen to music from around the world.

Understanding the World- This half term we will look at the celebration of Easter. In science we will build boats and then test which materials float and sink. We will also be doing lots of pirate map work for geography and learning about the famous pirate Mary Read.

Physical Development- We will learn what it means to be healthy. Part of this will include learning different invasion games and balls skills for throwing and catching.

PSED- In our Jigsaw lessons our topic is 'Healthy Me.' We will focus on our behaviour and emotions and how to show resilience in the face of challenge.
