#### Messages

Year 4 routines:

• Spellings - these will be given out every Friday and the children will be tested on Monday of the following week.

• Home reading:

Children will continue to bring a book home every Monday to read with you at home. Their bookbag needs to be back in school on the Friday with new books sent home on a Monday.

#### Homework
