## Messages

Year 3 routines:

# Together we will master...

## English

*We will be completing an adventure/quest story and a recount - both linked to our history topic of sport in Hull and Clive Sullivan.*

## Maths

*We will learn about various modules this half term - money, telling the time, pictograms and bar graphs.*

## Science

*We will learn about forces and magnets. In this topic, we will learn to understand that magnets can act at a distance and is a non-contact force. We will also learn how to classify magnetic and non-magnetic materials.*

## Music

*This half term is focused around exploring and developing playing skills through the glockenspiel and learning the lyrics to The Dragon Song (pop music).*

## History
