Summer 2

The theme for this half term is 'Marvellous Mini-beasts'.

Key fiction text: 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' by Eric Carle.
Key non-fiction text: 'The Life Cycle of a Butterfly' by Kay Barnham

Physical development: We will develop throwing and catching skills outdoors. When we're mark making, we will continue to develop a comfortable grip when holding pens, pencils and other mark making tools.

Communication and language: We will continue to develop our communication and language skills through lots of singing, stories and opportunities for discussion and conversation.

Personal, social and emotional development: We will be focusing on the theme 'Changing Me', where we will discuss how babies grow into adults.

Literacy: We will continue to learn to write some or all of our name and will develop our vocabulary with the help of stories.

Maths: We will consolidate our learning of the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5. in our maths sessions and will focus on 2d shapes, comparing the weights of objects and positional language through the maths provision.

Understanding the world: We learn about the life cycle of a butterfly and will raise and release our very own butterflies, watching the life cycle through each stage. We will search for minibeasts in the outdoor area using magnifying glasses to observe their features.

Expressive arts and design: We will develop basic skills such as scissor skills and use these to improve our creations.
