Together we will master...

English

We will continue to apply the Key Stage 1 grammar and punctuation features to our writing. We will write a range of genres including, narratives, recounts and letters.

Maths

We will be exploring the volume of different containers and exploring how much water they hold. We will learn to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes.

Science

We will be learning about living things and their habitats. We identify habitats as a home and give examples of animals and plants habitats.

Geography We will be learning about Sierra Leone and how the city of Freetown compares to Hull. We will look at the physical and human features of Freetown and Hull.

Computing We will be learning about coding. We will learn how to design a program using a simple algorithm.

DT

We will be tasting smoothies that are already available before tasting fruits and vegetables that can be used in a smoothie. We will then design, make and evaluate our own smoothies.

Music

We will use our voices to make different noises and learn how to make different sounds using percussion instruments.

RE

We will be learning more about Hinduism, specifically Hindu stories and symbols.
