Messages

Year 1 routines:

- Phonics practice will be sent out on a Monday in your child's bookbag.
 Spellings will be sent home weekly on a Monday to be tested the following Monday.
 - Homework will be sent home every week. One week will be GPS homework and one week will be Maths Key Instant Recall Facts to support pupils in remembering basic skills and facts.
 - Home reading:

Please continue to read with your child as much as possible at home. They will given a reading for pleasure and a phonics decodable book for their phonic phase.

Children will also continue to bring a book home every Monday to read with you at home. Their bookbag needs to be back in school on the Friday with new books sent home on a Monday.

- Numbots Children have their own log in for this app allowing them to practice math's skills at home.
 - Water bottles Please ensure your child has a clear water bottle, containing water or diluted juice in school every day. This must be taken home every evening to be washed and re-filled.
- PE Children need to come to school in their full PE kit including trainers, navy blue or black jogging bottoms/leggings/shorts and a white t-shirt. PE will take place outdoors when the weather allows. Long hair must be tied back, and jewellery removed.
