#### Messages

Year 1 routines:

\*Phonics Blending sheets will be sent home each Monday to be practised at home.

\*Weekly Spellings - Sent home on a Monday and tested the following Monday.

\*Weekly Maths or GPS Homework - sent home on a Monday, to be returned to school on a Friday

Children will continue to bring a reading book home every Monday to read with you at home. Their bookbag needs to be back in school on the Friday with new books sent home on a Monday. Please also encourage your child to practice their Phonics Screening Practice List of words sent out at the end of the Spring term. This will help them in their phonics screening assessment this term.

• Numbots - Children all have a personal log in which allows them to access a range of learning activities at home.

• Water bottles - Please ensure your child has a water bottle, containing only water or diluted juice in school every day. This must be taken home every evening to be washed and re-filled.

• PE - Children need to come to school in their full PE kit including trainers, jogging bottoms and a plain black, blue, grey or white top. PE will take place outdoors wherever possible. Long hair must be tied back, and jewelry removed.
