Welcome to Summer term 2! We hope you and your child had a wonderful half term break together.

We are excited to continue our theme 'People Who Help Us' for this half term.

Summer 2

Key texts for this half term include: 'I'm going to be a VET' by Marnie Willow and 'The Rescue Party' by Nick Butterworth.

Physical development: We will develop throwing and catching skills and practice races in preparation for Sports Day. When we are mark making, we will continue to develop a comfortable grip when holding pens, pencils and other mark making tools.

Communication and language: We will continue to develop our communication and language skills through lots of singing, stories and opportunities for discussion and conversation.

Personal, social and emotional development: We will be focusing on the theme 'Changing Me', where we will discuss how babies grow into adults.

Literacy: We will continue to develop our pre-writing shapes including circles and diagonal lines. We will learn to write some or all of our name, and will develop our vocabulary with the help of stories.

Maths: We will consolidate our learning of the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5. in our maths sessions and will focus on 2d shapes, comparing the weights of objects through the maths provision.

Understanding the world: We will continue to explore different jobs roles and discuss people who help us. We will look at local places of interest and discuss children's own experiences.

Expressive arts and design: We will develop basic skills such as scissor skills and use these to improve our creations.
